

Amador County Fair Survivor  
Contest Outline

Rules and information subject to sudden and unexplained change without any notice what-so-ever.

- Contest limited to 6 participants, 18 years of age and older.
- Entries close July 3, 2009. Interview July 6-10, 2009 and contestants announced July 13, 2009.
- Participants will be selected at random and without any particular reason or method.
- Proper Survivor attire will be provided each contestants and must be worn during the competition. Local Charity logo's are encouraged
- Survivors are required to remain on the fairgrounds through the run of the Amador County Fair July 30 – August 2, 2009 and sign a release of liability waiver.
- Survivors shall have no money or electronic devices during the competition.
- Survivors will be provided one (1) eight (8) person tent and basic toiletries. Survivors must provide their own sleeping bag and pillow.
- Survivors must eat Fair Food for the duration of the competition.
- Survivors will be asked to accomplish many challenges to earn points including but not limited to:
  - Enter Miss Louise Hall special contest of choice.
  - Adult swine showmanship – audience acclaim
  - Clean Stalls – timed event most manure by weight
  - Pick up trash – timed event most trash by weight
  - Diaper Derby – fastest time
  - Amador Idol – audience acclaim
  - Perform the Hukilau – audience acclaim
  - Corn Dog eating - most corn dogs consumed in 3 minutes
  - Ride the Gravitron – most consecutive rides
  - Carnival Barker – most dollars earned
  - Ride the mechanical bull – longest ride
  - Climb the rock wall – fastest time
  - Gold panning – most gold recovered
  - Treasure hunt – most items found
  - Destruction Derby Mud Splash and Dash – audience acclaim
  - Kit Carson Mountain Men rattlesnake recipe contest – audience acclaim.
- Winner to be announced at the Destruction Derby and to receive \$500 and an additional \$500 to be paid to their favorite local charity.
